

The **Aberdovey Art Society** is a small but flourishing society of about seventy members of all ages, most living within an area of twenty miles around Aberdyfi, or are regular visitors to the area.

The aim of the Society is to help its members to enjoy and practise their art, encouraging and assisting newcomers to the hobby of painting and sketching, and also to provide a practical base of instruction and information for the more experienced artists. The Society also provides enjoyable social interaction with others who have similar interests.

One important event in the Society's calendar is the Annual Exhibition, usually held during the last week in July and the first week in August, at which both beginners and experienced members show their work to the public.

Throughout the Spring to early Autumn, the Society has a programme of outdoor Painting Days, held on the first and third Tuesdays in the month (except August) at various local beauty spots. During the Autumn and Winter months, indoor Painting Days are held in the local Dovey Yacht Club. At these Tuesday meetings, the Society regularly benefits from the tuition of experienced professional artists.

We also hold two meetings every month, on the second (or third) and the last Thursday of each month, in the Tywyn Baptist Church. These are called Art 4 All and are to help those who wish to learn about art, or develop their own skills, but cannot always take advantage of the Society's Tuesday morning sessions.

An Annual Spring Luncheon is held for members and an Autumn Supper for Art 4 All.
